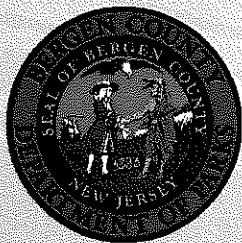

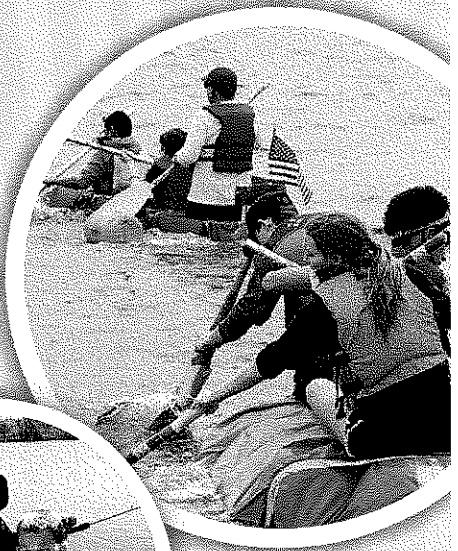

2017 Recycled Regatta – EarthFest Overpeck

Hackensack Riverkeeper's fourth annual Recycled Regatta will take place at our EarthFest celebration in Overpeck County Park on Saturday, May 20, 2017 – there is no rain date for the event.

We invite you to come up with imaginative ways to turn common household waste into a life-sized racing vessel! Our goal is to have fun on the Overpeck Creek while encouraging people to Reduce, Reuse and Recycle. This event promises to be an exciting, fun-filled experience for people of all ages! Teams are encouraged to raise funds for Hackensack Riverkeeper, by recruiting friends, family or local businesses to sponsor their team.

Proceeds benefit Hackensack Riverkeeper to help support our mission to protect, preserve and restore the Hackensack River.

General Information

- 1) Race begins at 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 20, 2017.
- 2) Vessels must be at the Overpeck Park Boat Launch by noon for inspection by judges.
- 3) Entry fee is \$25 per vessel prior to the race, \$30 the day of the event.
- 4) Teams must register online -follow the link from our EarthFestOverpeck.com, and get friends or family to sponsor your team.
- 5) Trophies will be awarded in the following 4 categories:
Clean Water Champion Award presented to the team raising the most money for Hackensack Riverkeeper
Prestigious Boating Award, Show Boat, Floating Van Gogh, and Leaky Buck

Vessel Construction

- 1) All materials must be clean and safe for the environment. No containers that held toxic or petroleum substances.
- 2) At least 80% of the vessel must be made out of used/recycled materials (wood, cardboard, plastic, etc.) No plastic bags or Styrofoam.
- 3) Binding materials (duct tape, wire, twine, rope, straps, etc.) should make up no more than 20% of the vessel and can be new or purchased.
- 4) All vessels must be self-propelled. Bonus points will be awarded for homemade paddles. No commercially manufactured vessels or floatation devices with the exception of provided PFD's. No swimming or towing of the vessel is permitted.
- 5) The design is left to the builder(s). We encourage creativity and imagination.

Racing Regulations

- 1) All crewmembers **MUST** wear supplied U.S. Coast Guard approved life vests at ALL TIMES when on or near water.
*******NO EXCEPTIONS*******
- 2) All participants must wear tightly fitting shoes, such as water shoes or sneakers- no boots or waders.
- 3) Each crew must have a designated Crew Captain.
- 4) Each crewmember must be at least 8 years of age, and teams consisting of crewmembers all under the age of 18 must be accompanied on the vessel by an adult.
- 5) Each vessel shall carry a minimum of 2 crewmembers. After launching, all crewmembers must remain on their vessel and cross the finish line with all pieces of their vessel.
- 6) All vessels must be named and also carry event sponsor logos in addition to the team's sponsor if any.
- 7) Each vessel will be provided with a red flag to use as a "vessel in distress" signal, safety boats will be on hand to assist.
- 8) It is the crew's responsibility to leave no trace of their vessel. Practice "carry in, carry out". Materials that fall off must be retrieved; help will be available for safety. Teams are responsible for transporting their vessel to and from the event.
- 9) You may get wet! Be sure that all crewmembers bring a change of clothes.

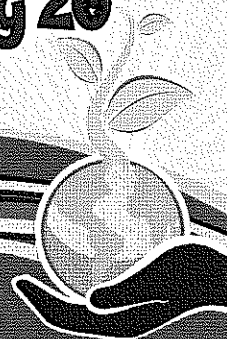

- d. Vendor should arrive on May 20, 2017 for load-in/set-up between 9 and 10:00 a.m. and ready for operation by the official opening time of the Festival of noon. **Vehicles must be moved to the designated parking area no later than 11:00 a.m.**
- e. Vendors must remove all products and equipment at the end of the Festival. Vendor must remove their own trash from the Space and properly dispose of recyclable and compostable materials in containers provided by HRI. Vendors must leave the Space waste-free and in the same condition as when provided.
- f. Vendor must vacate the Festival grounds no later than 5 p.m., Saturday May 20, 2017. Vendor may not vacate the Festival prior to the official closing time of 4 p.m. without the express permission of HRI.
- g. Please make a copy of this contract for your records. Signed contracts will remain at the HRI office.

Section 7 - Causes for Denial or Revocation of Selling Privileges & Disciplinary Actions, and Result Thereof

- a. Any Vendor who, is not "green" as described on the application, seeks to evade or refuses to make payment of the proper rental and space fees, or ignores the festival operational guidelines will be denied selling privileges and be required to leave. **Vendors must not serve food or drink in plastic or Styrofoam containers. No plastic bags, or straws.**
- b. Use of racial or ethnic slurs, profanities, derogatory language and other inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated on the Festival premises and will be cause for denial of selling privileges and vendor may be required to leave.
- c. HRI may impose additional rules and regulations, as it deems necessary. HRI will notify Vendor of these additional rules.
- d. HRI may revoke this contract, cancelling Vendor's right to occupancy, if HRI believes, at its sole and complete discretion that Vendor has violated any of the terms of this contract.
- e. If HRI revokes Vendor's selling privileges or otherwise cancels this contracts under the terms listed above, Vendor will immediately vacate under the terms of this contract listed at Section 6(e-g).

Section 8 - Laws and Permits

- a. Vendor must comply with all relevant local, state and federal laws.
- b. Vendor is responsible for obtaining and paying for all business licenses, permits and taxes that are required for its operation, including state sales tax. Vendor shall provide HRI with a valid IBT Number in order to sell merchandise at the Festival.
- c. All vendor sales are limited to the space designated by the event manager for each vendor. Vendors will not be permitted to sell merchandise or services outside of their Space.
