BOROUGH OF BERGENFIELD Ordinance No. 18-2529

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 227 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BERGENFIELD, ENTITLED "PEDDLING AND SOLICITING"

WHEREAS, Chapter 227 of the Code of the Borough of Bergenfield sets forth all regulations regarding Peddling and Soliciting within the Borough of Bergenfield; and,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bergenfield, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey that those portions of the aforesaid set forth below are hereby amended as follows and that those portions of the Ordinance not set forth below shall remain unchanged.

Chapter 227: Peddling and Soliciting

227-2. entitled License Required.

The following sentence shall be added: All fees associated with obtaining a license including but not limited to background checks from the State Police are at the sole cost and expense of the peddler. Peddlers shall not be allowed to solicit within the Borough without a "No Knock List" provided by the Borough setting forth the names and addresses of property owners the peddler is prohibited from soliciting.

<u>Severability</u> All provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If for any reason, any provision of this Ordinance is held to be invalid, the validity of the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected.

<u>Effective Date</u>. This Ordinance shall become effective upon final approval and publication, pursuant to law, and upon completion of all outstanding cases.
